Latter, students interacted with Dr Jireesh, Psychologist and Faculty of Psychology, for understanding the different psychological disorders. Students had the wonderful opportunity to interact with doctors, staff, physiotherapist and students in special education and Vocational unit where SARS is organising workshops with the material (Book binding, file making, craft unit) made by the students to encourage them for income generation in future. Students interacted with few students who were singers and won prizes for their talent in competition organised specially for them. In end the students interacted with Dr Vijilan to brief them about mental retardation and the challenges faced by the students in life.

Students utilised this opportunity to understand the mental health profession in a very empathetic way and altogether it was a very wonderful experience for the students pursuing Humanities.
