## CLASS 4 STUDENTS FIELD TRIP TO BIRLA PLANETARIUM AND MUSEUM

The students of Class 4 were taken on a field trip to 'Do Science Park', a hands-on science centre located near Sanjeevaiah Park, Hyderabad on 14<sup>th</sup> August,2024. It has nearly 30 exhibits explaining the scientific principles of the models.
