From the desk of LKG teachers



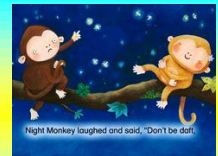
This week we are going to tell you about the Early Programme lesson on Sun, Moon and Stars.

In this lesson, student will observe things that are seen in the day and night sky. Their observations will lead them into discussions of comparisons between day and night.

Students will learn about day and night through rhymes and songs. They will observe the day and night sky, talk about their observations and draw pictures of the same. They will engage in pretend play to imitate daytime and night-time activities using objects and toys. Students will name 1 more than a number up to 5 through activities and manipulatives. They will also learn about the concept of more and less using objects. Students will review the forms and sounds of the letters 'Xx' and 'Qq' through stories, rhymes, actions and also write these letters.

Rather than simply learning about the topic through rote and memorization, students will learn by observing the day and night sky and comparing the daytime and night-time activities that we do.

At home, you can help your child observe pictures of the different constellations seen in the night sky or take him/her to visit a planetarium. With warm regards.
