BLOCK COMMENTARY

Dear Parent,

Here is the information about the early programme lesson on “WATER ANIMALS”

In this lesson, students will learn about some common water animals.

Students will observe pictures of water animals and talk about how they are different from us. They will use their painted water animals to tell stories about them. They will find water animal cut-outs /toys in the sand pit and ask questions from others. They will look at pictures of water animals in books and talk about them. Students will play some fun games to identify the water animals.

During Maths time, students will learn to identify, show and trace the numbers 1-5 using their fingers and other objects. They will show an understanding of ‘one – to – correspondence’ by keeping a track of counting and uncounted things.

During Language time, students will recognize letters and familiar words that begin with the letters “Q” and “R”. Students will also identify and form circles.

Rather than simply identifying and naming the water animals, students compare the water animals and know how these are different than us. They develop the skill of asking questions through fun games.

At home, you can take your child to show an aquarium.
