**Block 16 - TOYS
Block Commentary**

From the desk of the UKG Teachers

Dear Parent,
We are going to tell you about the Early Programme lesson on Toys.

In this lesson, students will learn that toys are made of different materials, move in different ways and have changed over time.

Students will present their toys and compare them to learn how they are different.

During Maths time, students will learn to count Numbers backward and to write Number Names.

During Language time, students will listen to stories, sing rhymes, do associated actions, name things, put together puzzles and group pictures to identify the beginning sound of the digraphs/ch/and/sh.

Rather than just imitating an action, students will observe how differently toys move, show the action, connect the action with the word and use the action word in sentences with a structure such as: ‘One way to move toys is by... pushing, pulling, spinning, swirling or winding’.

At home, your child can group toys by the way they move. It would be great if your child can be prompted to use action words in an unfamiliar context.
