

## WORKSHOP ON FABRIC PRINTING AND DYEING

On 24th June, 2024, the students of DDMS P OBUL REDDY SCHOOL, Home Science Department attended a workshop regarding textiles and printing and dyeing with the Home Science Faculty, at WEAVERS SOCIETY IN CHETANA BHAVAN located at Nampally.

As a part of textile workshop, the students have learned and gained knowledge regarding different textile printing and dyeing techniques used on fabric/apparel. The students gained knowledge on printing and dyeing methods during the textile workshop. The students were given hands on experience in identifying various printing and dyeing methods like Kalamkari Print, a method of fabric print using natural dyes like alum, onion peels, indigo blue, manjaista etc. using kalam which is dipped into black solution (made of jaggery and iron fillings). Block Printing, print made on fabric using different blocks of intricate designs using natural or artificial dyes. Tie and Dye a method of fabric dyeing which involves covering small pieces of fabrics using different cloth swatches or by paper clips in different intricate designs/ patterns before dipping the fabric into a big bucket of natural /artificial dyes and Weaving on loom a method of fabric printing which involves loops of warp yarns and weft yarns. Warp yarns are spun through spinning wheel whereas weft yarns are spun on a loom.

The workshop on textiles provided valuable insights to the students.
