Short Reads Training Program

The session began with an engaging introduction on <u>21st September</u>'2024 by Ms. Neelam Narang, highlighting the importance of Short Reads for building literacy skills in foundational &preparatory stages for grade 3 English faculty members.

The focus was on how short, well-curated texts can foster interest in reading while enhancing comprehension, vocabulary, and critical thinking among Grade-3 students

Ms. Neelam Narang facilitated a discussion to evaluate the relevance and engagement of the content. The student material consisted of 6cards featuring diverse themes and activities of fiction & non-fiction stories.

<u>Final Review-23rd November'2024</u>, The session concluded with comprehensive review of materials and strategies discussed. Participants shared insights about the effectiveness of the resources, emphasizing - * The suitability of the materials for Grade-3 learners
